

NOTICE OF BID

Bids are requested for the T.H. 357 Valley Brook Boulevard Replacement in Hinckley Township, Medina County, Ohio.

Said improvement will involve the removal of the existing concrete roadway & catch basins and installation of cement stabilization, 8" fiber-reinforced concrete including catch basins, curb under drains, driveway aprons and general excavation involving fine grading, stipulated traffic control in accordance with the specifications and accompanying construction drawings to all aspects of the improvement. The the road shall be closed for a maximum of 75 days and the project completion shall be November 4th, 2022.

The Bid Notice can be obtained from the Medina County Engineer web page at www.highwayengineer.co.medina.oh.us .

Bids must be submitted electronically through the www.bidexpress.com web service until 10:00am on June 27th, 2022 at which time all bids will be received and read aloud for the project known as **"T.H. 357 VALLEY BROOK BOULEVARD REPLACEMENT PROJECT"**.

The Engineer's Estimate is \$ 450, 729.50 for the base bid to replace Valley Brook from Willow Brook Lane to Brook Hollow Oval. Included is an Alternate Bid to include the section from Brook Hollow Oval to Brook Haven Lave. The Engineer's estimate is \$ 409, 228.00 The improvement project shall have a final completion date of November 4th, 2022.

Each bidder shall be required to file a bid guaranty with the bid in the form of either: (1) a Bid/Performance Bond in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the amount bid; or (2) a Certified Check, Cashier's Check or Letter of Credit shall equal to 10% of the amount bid, conditioned that the bidder shall, if his bid is accepted, execute a contract in conformity with the bid, plans, details, specifications and bills of material. A Letter of Credit shall be revocable only at the option of the Township.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contract compliance with the Equal Opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with Prevailing Wage Rates on public improvements in Medina County, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Labor and Worker Safety.

The bid will be awarded to the lowest and best bidder.

The Hinckley Township Board of Trustees reserve the right to reject any and all bids.
