

NOTICE OF BID

Bids are requested for the 2023 Medina County Signal Upgrade Project Re-Bid in Medina County, Ohio.

Said improvement will involve the replacement and/or upgrade of traffic signals and related traffic control components at three intersections. The included intersections are the northern and southern intersections of C.H. 70 Fenn Road and C.H. 22 Marks Road and the intersection of West Reagan Parkway and C.H. 22 Marks Road. Included components include signal heads at two intersections, component cabinets at 2 intersections, controllers at 3 intersections, preemption equipment at 3 intersections, radar component installation to replace traffic loops at 3 intersections, uninterruptible power supply replacement at 3 intersections and stipulated traffic control in accordance with the specifications to all aspects of the improvement. The intersections shall be remain open for the duration of the project and the project completion shall be May 1, 2024.

Bids must be submitted electronically through the www.bidexpress.com web service until 1:00 p.m. on May 31, 2023 at which time all bids will be received and read aloud for the project known as **“2023 MEDINA COUNTY SIGNAL UPGRADE PROJECT RE-BID”**.

The Engineer's Estimate is \$ 240,800.00 for the base bid. The improvement project shall have a final completion date of May 1, 2024.

Each bidder shall be required to file a bid guaranty with the bid in the form of either: (1) a Bid/Performance Bond in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the amount bid; or (2) a Certified Check, Cashier's Check or Letter of Credit shall equal to 10% of the amount bid, conditioned that the bidder shall, if his bid is accepted, execute a contract in conformity with the bid, plans, details, specifications and bills of material. A Letter of Credit shall be revocable only at the option of the County.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contract compliance with the Equal Opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with Prevailing Wage Rates on public improvements in Medina County, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Labor and Worker Safety.

The bid will be awarded to the lowest and best bidder. The Medina County Board of Commissioners reserve the right to reject any and all bids.
