

NOTICE OF BID

Bids are requested for C.H. 46 Seville Road Bridge No. 20 Replacement in Medina County as detailed in the Bid Documents.

Said improvement will involve the removal of the existing 10'x4' concrete box and installation of a new 10'x4' 4-sided box culvert including premium bedding & backfill, concrete footers & wingwalls, ditching, ditch enclosures, catch basins, asphalt pavement and general excavation involving ditch realignment & fine grading in preparation of seeding and incorporating stipulated traffic control in accordance with the specifications and accompanying construction drawings. The earliest start date shall be March 29, 2021. The road shall be closed for a maximum of 60 calendar days.

Bids must be submitted electronically through the www.bidexpress.com web service until 1:00 PM on January 28, 2021 at which time all bids will be received and read aloud for the project known as **"C.H. 46 SEVILLE ROAD BRIDGE NO. 20 REPLACEMENT" O.P.W.C. No. DIX05.**

The Engineer's estimate is **\$235,225.00**. No contract shall be awarded at a price more than ten percent in excess of the Engineer's estimate. All proposals shall be submitted electronically through web service are www.bidexpress.com.

*An Alternate Bid for a "Cast in Place" 10'x4' 4-Sided Box is included with this bid. The Medina County Highway Engineer reserves the right to award this Alternate-1 bid if it is in the best interest of the county.

Work shall be completed no later than **July 2, 2021**.

Each bidder shall be required to file a bid guaranty with the bid in the form of either: (1) a Bid/Performance Bond in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the amount bid; or (2) a certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the amount bid, conditioned that the bidder shall, if his bid is accepted, execute a contract in conformity with the bid, plans, details, specifications and bills of material. A letter of credit shall be revocable only at the option of the County.

Contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements detailed in the Bid Documents shall be required.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contract compliance with the Equal Opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Contractors and Subcontractors must comply with the prevailing wage rates requirements detailed in the Bid Documents.

The bid will be awarded to the lowest and best bidder. The Medina County Board of Commissioners reserve the right to reject any and all bids.
