

NOTICE OF BID

Bids are requested for ODOT Item 422 Chip & Seal on 20.23 miles of various roads in Medina County, Ohio.

The Bid Notice can be obtained from the Medina County Engineer web page at:

Bid documents and details as to the location of the proposed improvements must be obtained through the www.bidexpress.com web service.

Bids must be submitted electronically through the www.bidexpress.com web service by 1:30 PM on February 19th, 2026 at which time all bids will be read aloud for the project known as **“2026 - Medina County Item 422 Chip & Seal Bid”**.

The Engineer's estimate is **\$749,915.20**. No contract shall be awarded at a price more than twenty percent in excess of the Engineer's estimate. All proposals shall be submitted electronically through the www.bidexpress.com web service.

All resurfacing has a substantial completion date of July 31st, 2026 and a final completion date of August 21st, 2026.

Each bidder shall be required to file a bid guaranty with the bid in the form of either: (1) a Bid/Performance Bond in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the amount bid; or (2) a Certified Check, Cashier's Check or Letter of Credit shall equal to 10% of the amount bid, conditioned that the bidder shall, if his bid is accepted, execute a contract in conformity with the bid, plans, details, specifications and bills of material. A Letter of Credit shall be revocable only at the option of the County.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contract compliance with the Equal Opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with Prevailing Wage Rates on public improvements in Medina County, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Labor and Worker Safety and as detailed in the Bid Documents.

The bid will be awarded to the lowest and best bidder.

The Medina County Commissioners reserve the right to reject any and all bids.
