

NOTICE OF BID

Bids are requested for ODOT Item 422 Single Chip & Seal with Repairs and stipulated Traffic Control on 6.17 miles of roads in Lafayette Township, Medina County, Ohio.

Lafayette Township will supply the No.8 ACBF Slag Aggregate, loader and operator at the Township Garage located at 6776 Wedgewood Road, Medina, Ohio 44256. The Contractor is responsible for hauling, spreading and rolling the cover aggregate.

All bids must be submitted electronically through the www.bidexpress.com web service no later than March 19, 2026, at 1:00pm Ohio Time, at which time all bids will be received and read aloud for the project known as **2026 Lafayette Township Road Bid**.

The Engineer's Estimate is **\$ 259,000.00**. No contract shall be awarded at a price more than ten percent in excess of the Engineer's estimate. All proposals shall be submitted electronically through the web service at www.bidexpress.com.

The improvement project shall have a substantial completion date of July 10th, 2026 and final completion date of July 31st, 2026.

Each bidder shall be required to file a bid guaranty with the bid in the form of either: (1) a Bid/Performance Bond in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the amount bid; or (2) a Certified Check, Cashier's Check or Letter of Credit shall equal to 10% of the amount bid, conditioned that the bidder shall, if his bid is accepted, execute a contract in conformity with the bid, plans, details, specifications and bills of material. A Letter of Credit shall be revocable only at the option of the Township.

Contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements detailed in the Bid Documents shall be required.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contract compliance with the Equal Opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with Prevailing Wage Rates on public improvements in Medina County, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Labor and Worker Safety and as detailed in the Bid Documents.

The bid will be awarded to the lowest and best bidder. The Board of Lafayette Township Trustees reserve the right to reject any and all bids.
